Ontario India Student Exchange updated

Full year/ One Term Exchange (OIN)

Study in India and earn credits toward your degree in Canada

Timing

- 1 or 2 semesters

Eligibility

- Canadian citizens/permanent residents
- Undergraduate and graduate full-time degree students
- Should have completed at least 2 years of a recognized degree and have a high academic standing

Language of Instruction

- English is the medium of instruction in all OIN partner institutions

Costs

- Ontario tuition fees
- Students are responsible for expenses abroad, flight, health insurance, and other associated costs

Scholarships

- One semester: \$2,500; Two semesters: \$3,500

Credits

- Contact an academic advisor at your home institution for information on credit transfer

Study India Program (SIP)

Covers the study of India's art and architecture, history, culture, politics, social justice and gender issues. The experiential learning component includes visit to an NGO, the Taj Mahal and Delhi-area monuments.

Timing

- August 1 to 31, 2019

Eligibility

- Canadian citizens/permanent residents
- Undergraduate and graduate degree students
- Registered in a degree program in the academic year of application

Language of Instruction

- English

Partner Institution

- Shiv Nadar University, Noida

Costs

- Course fee is CAD\$2,200 (fee covers administration cost, airport pick-up, accommodation, most meals, tuition and trips)
- Students pay for flight, some meals and costs associated with non-SIP-related travel

Scholarships

- \$2,000 scholarship

Short-term Study Program (SSP)

Participate in a study project at an Indian institution (with a faculty member at the latter)

Timing

- Two to three months any time in the calendar year

Eligibility

- Canadian Citizens/permanent residents
- Undergraduate and graduate students at one of the participating Ontario universities

Language of Instruction

- English is the medium of instruction in all OIN partner institutions

Placements

- For details regarding topic of study, locating a suitable professor, and contacting the host institution please contact the OIN director

Costs

- Students pay for living expenses in India, flight and other associated costs
- *There may be an academic fee payable to the host institution*

Scholarships

- \$3,000 scholarship
- Students may seek further assistance from their home institution
